Southern Oaks Residents Lend a Landscaping Hand for Neighborhood Green Up



Thanks to the Neighborhood Watch meetings that were held earlier this year, as well as our participation in National Night Out, Southern Oaks is now an official Neighborhood Watch community with the City of Orlando. You likely saw the neighborhood watch signs posted near the entrances, but behind the scenes, we have a dedicated group of volunteers who serve as "Block Captains" to alert the authorities and their neighbors should they notice any suspicious behavior.

If you see anything out of the ordinary, call 911 first so that they can dispatch someone immediately to check it out. Tip # 1: If you go on vacation and leave your front porch light on at night, be sure it goes off in the day time. Criminals look for signs such as this to determine if anyone is home or not.

Tip # 2: Consider putting a large dog's water bowl near your back door. Criminals are never sure if you have a large dog or not and will usually skip your house for one that looks less guarded.
